



Optical Communities Website Privacy Statement Terms of Use

Ballantyne Broadband Partners, LLC d.b.a. Optical Communities (or “we” or “OC”) is committed to protecting the privacy of the personally-identifiable information that we collect from you as you use this website.

This website is an online information and communication service provided by Optical Communities. Please read these Terms of Use carefully before using this site. By using this site, you submit your agreement with these Terms of Use. If you do not agree with any of the below Terms of Use then do not use this site. OC reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to modify, alter or otherwise update these Terms of Use at any time. Any such modifications shall be effective immediately upon posting of the modified Terms of Use. You agree to be bound by the revised terms by using this service after we have posted notice of such modifications, alterations or updates. OC retains the right to deny access to anyone at its complete discretion for any reason including for violation of any of these Terms of Use.

The information gathered by OC is either: (1) information voluntarily supplied by visitors to the OC website or (2) by tracking information gathered as visitors navigate through the site. When you supply information for a specific purpose, such as online ordering of an Optical Communities service, we use the information for that purpose (for example, we may collect other information provided by you, such as your credit card number, driver’s license number, billing address, Social Security number (SSN), date of birth, and/or other information when you set up an online account or order service online. When you use our website to order services, we may use this individually identifiable information as we would if obtained in a non-electronic manner. Our web servers automatically collect statistical information about your visit such as pages visited and which browsers are used to visit our site. None of this information is associated with you as an individual (see information about cookies). We use these statistics to monitor our site's performance and to make it easier for you to use.

Personally Identifiable Information

OC does not sell, share or disclose personally identifiable information collected through its web site and server with other companies or organizations, unless (i) you specifically authorize OC to share your information with another company; (ii) required by laws, rules and regulations of any nation, state or applicable jurisdiction and when we believe that disclosure is necessary to protect our rights and/or to comply with a judicial proceeding, court order, or legal process served on our website; (iii) necessary to protect the safety of customers, employees, or property; (iv) in response to inquiries by bona-fide rights owners in connection with allegations of infringement of copyright or other proprietary rights arising from information you have posted on the website or otherwise provided to OC; (v) If OC merges with or sells substantially all of its assets or a majority of its equity to a third party, information collected by OC on the websites may be disclosed to and owned by the merged entity or third party; and (vi) sharing data with our authorized vendors, contractors and agents, only to the extent necessary for them to perform their work, in order that OC can carry out certain functions in marketing and/or delivering services to you. If the way we use personally identifiable information collected from our website and server with third parties, except as described above, we will provide advanced notification to web site and server users and give them the opportunity to express that they do not want personally identifiable information shared with third parties.

The OC website(s) may contain links to other websites whose privacy policies OC does not control. We are not responsible for the content or the privacy practices employed by other sites. Once you leave the OC servers, use of any information you provide is governed by the privacy policy of the operator of the site you are visiting, which may be different from the OC policy.

Optical Communities does not knowingly collect personally identifiable information from children under the age of 13. Federal law requires website operators who collect personal information from those under age 13 to first get parental consent, and children should always get permission from their parents before sending any information about themselves (such as their names, email addresses, and phone numbers) over the Internet, to OC or to anyone else.

Cookies

OC may use a browser software feature, called a “cookie,” to assign each visitor a unique, random number that resides in a file on the visitor’s computer. The cookie does not identify a visitor, but only the computer that the visitor uses to access the OC website. This does not personally identify the visitor.

OC uses cookies to make the OC website more responsive to the needs of visitors and enhance your online experience. Examples of the use of cookies includes those that track specific OC website pages accessed by visitors, or ensure that you see the correct products and pricing applicable to the state in which you live, or manage the number of ads that you see to avoid over-delivery of the same message, or tailor an advertisement to better match your interests and preferences. You may program your browser not to accept cookies, but this may interfere with your enjoyment of personalized site features.

Email

Optical Communities reserves the right to communicate through email to online users and others who have provided their email addresses to OC for the purposes of: (i) informing customers that their bills are available for review online; (ii) conduct online surveys; (iii) provide marketing information about OC products and services; and (iv) provide information to those who have voluntarily provided their email addresses to third parties in order to receive promotional material. OC may provide this information in any number of ways including email.

CPNI

To protect the confidentiality of your Customer Proprietary Network Information (“CPNI”), the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”) requires that we do not release detailed call information over the phone. Information can only be given by sending call information through a means known to OC in advance, for example, through email address to the email address on file, via phone at the telephone number on file, or via postal mail to the address on file. Call detail information is available OC’s secure portal for Phone customers.
